

UCSF Mission bay – Labor and Delivery COVID OR check list

In the setting of a COVID positive patient or PUI, OR-3 will immediately be designated as the emergency OR room for this patient

This check list should be formally completed as soon as the patient is admitted to the unit

Check list completed by Scrub tech/Scrub nurse

- Place COVID OR sign on OR3 front door – Note that instruments are OPEN
- Caution magnetic strip across door (Alerts staff OR set is open)
- PPE cart available outside of OR3 (in sterile core)
- Trashcan (contained) for doffed PPE
- Cysto table or Mayo stand with gowns/gloves for surgical team (leave in OR, to be moved to sterile core during emergency)
- C-section tray open and counted – Sterile drape covering
- Sterile 1/2 sheet (unopened)
- COVID anesthesia cart prepared and available
- Strip room of redundant and non-essential items (Empty fluid warmer, blankets, instrument carts, PPE, instrument cabinet)
- Ensure the sterile core hallway is clear
- Call main OR to ensure additional OR available for urgent cases

*New OR set every shift (This will be determined on a case-by-case basis for antepartum admissions who are anticipated to be admitted for a prolonged period of time)
