

## UCSF COVID-19 emergency C-section Roles/Personnel

Response must be limited to ESSENTIAL personnel only, one person per role, others remain outside unless called.

All personnel involved in an emergency c-section on COVID positive patient should be wearing **Novel Respiratory Isolation PPE while in the OR during surgical cases** which includes:

- N-95 or PAPR hood
- Gown
- Gloves
- Protective eyewear

Personnel involved in patient TRANSPORT and in LDR should wear **Respiratory Illness PPE** which includes UNLESS high risk for aerosolization (high flow NC, non-invasive ventilation, tracheostomy)

- Surgical mask (non-N-95)
- Protective eye wear
- Gloves
- Gown

Role	Duty
<b>Bedside nurse</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• SBAR for incoming team members</li> <li>• Delegates RN tasks initially</li> <li>• Helps to move the patient's bed, unplug monitors and lines</li> <li>• In OR, moves patient to OR bed, plugs in monitor, start setting up foley, SCDs</li> </ul>
<b>Charge nurse</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Delegates tasks to additional nurses</li> <li>• Ensures LDR and OR3 are ready for patient prior to transport</li> <li>• Calls anesthesia at the start of bradycardia</li> <li>• Part of LDR to OR transport team (<b>Respiratory Isolation PPE</b>)</li> <li>• Works with HUSC to clear the hallways for transport</li> <li>• <b>NOT in the OR</b></li> </ul>
<b>Resource nurse (for LDR to OR)</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Assistant to bedside nurse</li> <li>• In OR, moves patient to OR bed, plugs in monitor, start setting up foley, SCDs, prep</li> <li>• Corresponds with RN communicator (outside of OR)</li> <li>• Communicates if more team members needed in OR</li> <li>• Communicates if additional supplies needed</li> </ul>
<b>Scrub tech</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Opens c-section tray</li> <li>• Moves sterile gowning table out of OR to sterile core</li> <li>• Participates in c-section with OB and anesthesia team</li> </ul>
<b>OB MD attending</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Helps to move patient in LDR to door</li> <li>• Runs OB code with chief resident</li> <li>• Makes final decision about urgency of c-section</li> <li>• Performs TIMEOUT in the OR</li> <li>• Performs c-section with chief resident</li> </ul>

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Performs DEBRIEF in the OR (with ICU attg and COVID attg PRN)</li> </ul>
<b>OB Chief resident</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Runs OB code with MD attending</li> <li>• Performs c-section with OB attending</li> </ul>
<b>OB Anesthesia attending (STAY IN OR)</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Communicates with OB attending about use of regional anesthesia vs GETA</li> <li>• Works with OB anesthesia resident</li> <li>• Communicates with anesthesia tech (Outside of OR)</li> </ul>
<b>OB Anesthesia resident (STAY IN OR)</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Communicates with OB attending about use of regional anesthesia vs GETA</li> <li>• Works with OB anesthesia attending</li> <li>• Communicates with anesthesia tech (Outside of OR)</li> </ul>
<b>OR RN/Resource (STAY IN OR)</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Enters OR with Anesthesia team</li> <li>• Stays in OR throughout entire case</li> <li>• Receives patient when transported from labor room</li> <li>• Plugs in fetal monitor</li> <li>• Assistant to anesthesia PRN</li> <li>• Splashes/preps for emergency c-sections (GETA)</li> </ul>
<b>Recorder RN/Observer (One RN only)</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Documents code activities</li> <li>• Observing donning and doffing of PPE Records personnel in room (see personnel check list)</li> </ul>
<b>RN communicator (Outside of OR)</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• VOALTE communicator with Recorder RN/Charge nurse from OUTSIDE of the OR</li> <li>• Mobilizes more team members if needed</li> <li>• Gathers and delivers additional supplies as needed</li> </ul>
<b>HUSC (Outside of OR)</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Activates the COVID batch page "91119"</li> <li>• Clears hallways for transport</li> <li>• Calls peds surgical desk to contact anesthesia tech</li> <li>• Arranges high-impact 2 hours cleaning of OR after case complete</li> </ul>
<b>Anesthesia technologist (Outside of OR)</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Stays outside of OR in sterile core</li> <li>• Brings anesthesia materials to team</li> </ul>
<b>PCA (Outside of OR)</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Part of LDR to OR transport team (<b>Respiratory Isolation PPE</b>)</li> <li>• Drapes pt with sterile ½ sheet prior to transport to OR</li> <li>• Directing traffic in and out of OR</li> <li>• Able to collect materials to be brought into the OR</li> </ul>
<b>Pediatric team members</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Receives baby in <b>Novel Respiratory PPE</b></li> <li>• Neonatal resuscitation of neonate in OR</li> </ul>
